

Adderbury Neighbourhood Plan Update

The process continues....

We are now at the next stage in the lengthy process of producing an Adderbury Neighbourhood Plan. The Neighbourhood plan sets out 21 land-use policies that Cherwell District Council (CDC) planning officers will use when considering new development applications in Adderbury.

Following the public consultation on the 'pre-submission' version of the plan last winter, all comments received were considered and changes made to the plan. A 'submission version' of the plan, was approved by Adderbury Parish Council and submitted to CDC in March. CDC are now undertaking a public consultation on this Submission Plan before it is sent to an independent examiner. Once approved by the examiner, the village will be asked to approve the Plan via a referendum
