

# Adderbury Library news

**From Monday July 19th**

- From Monday 19 July, the message for customers will change to that of the government's new message of personal responsibility around "Hands, Face, Space", including the following changes:
- The "Meet and Greet" role will cease in line with H&S advice and to provide staffing resource.
- PPE (hand sanitiser, wipes, gloves, masks, face-shields) will continue to be made available to staff and volunteers. Hand sanitiser will remain available to customers at the entrance to libraries.
- Customers will be encouraged to wear face coverings, but this will not be enforced.
- Similarly, staff are encouraged to wear face coverings, but this is not a requirement.
- Cleaning arrangements are under review but remain unchanged at the moment.
- Test and Trace measures (e.g. QR code and forms) will remain in place, but – again – will not be enforced.
- Public toilets will be reopened.
- Counter screens will remain in place for the foreseeable future.
- COVID secure layouts (including floor markings) will remain in place for the foreseeable future. However minor changes may be made by staff in consultation with their manager. Furniture that was removed prior to re-opening will not be returned immediately, but this will be kept under review as we move into the autumn.
- The maximum capacity on number of customers in the building will be removed (subject to normal H&S considerations).
- The limit on length of stay will be removed.
- Staff and volunteers are asked to be considerate of each other and of customers, and to follow the "Hands, Face, Space" guidance when working in the library
- Events are now permissible – without the limitation on the rule of 6. As normal, Library Managers will be responsible for the Health & Safety arrangements around events in the library.
- Please continue to ventilate spaces where possible.
